This work facilities the beginning of the Art District and the movement of hundreds of new businesses to West Denver.

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
The ZONE Marketplace at 725 Santa Fe Drive, Denver's first retail and office incubator program was established. This initiative significantly contributed to promoting economic development in West Denver and fostering adult self-sufficiency through targeted business support.

# 1995 - 1998

**NEWSED** begins direct human service programming at 1029 Santa Fe Drive. NEWSED's Housing Counseling program starts. The program remains true to its focus from the beginning of providing affordable housing services in the form of one-on-one counseling. down payment assistance and CHFA approved workshops for interested first time homebuyers. Since then additional services have been added, including foreclosure counseling and financial assistance, and coaching.

# 2005

La Villa de Barela, located at 901 West 10th Avenue is erected and is NEWSED's first multi-use development incorporating office/ retail space and 38 units of affordable housing.
